**TRAINEESHIP ON ABROAD-**  
**blended short-term traineeship**  
**OPEN CALL**

**The Budapest Circus Arts and Contemporary Dance College announces an open call for its students regarding traineeship abroad - blended short-term traineeship.**

**The goal** is to support the students in their career orientation, gain experience in the international dance field, and learn a foreign language and network.

**Eligibility:** Students of BCDC with an active student status. The recently graduated students can also take part in a traineeship even in the year after their graduation; however, they are expected to submit their application at least during their last semester.

**Potential countries of destination:** EU member countries + Iceland, Liechtenstein, Norway, Turkey, Serbia, Republic of North Macedonia. A small percentage of students can also visit non-erasmus countries: [Partner countries](#).

**Place of traineeship:** An organisation that meets the requirements of the Erasmus+ programme, such as enterprises, public institutions or non-profit organisations.

**Duration of traineeship:** Financial support can be given for the physical part: minimum 5- maximum 30 days. For longer physical mobility needs (more than 30 days, but less than 2 months) it is possible to apply twice in a row for the same institution.

**Conditions:**

-Mandatory virtual element before/during/after the physical part: online training or workshop, digital project work (e.g. public presentation), mentoring sessions, e-learning course, coaching or reflective learning.

-Must be a professional programme (e.g. participation in workshops, voluntary works, job shadowing, artistic activity, creation process, presentation, sharing...).

-Professional mentor needed from the host institution: a choreographer, an art or dance master, a project manager, a production coordinator, an artistic director or an experienced performer.

-Minimum 30 hour/week working hours.

**Period:** Continuous

**An application** could be submitted by filling in an application form and attaching the required documents listed there.





**Deadline for submission:** it could be handed in anytime.

**Mode of submission:** By filling in the [online application form](#).

**Process of evaluation:** The Rector of the BCDC has the right to decide on the application by considering the opinions of the Erasmus Committee (international coordinator, one student, one teacher). Criteria: 1<sup>st</sup> The professional preparedness of the applicant. 2<sup>nd</sup> The probable success of studying/working in the chosen foreign environment. 3<sup>rd</sup> The quality and the feasibility of the professional work plan. 4<sup>th</sup> Available financial budget.

**Date of results:** Until the 15<sup>th</sup> of the next month after submission.

**The expected amount of financial support:** depending on the destination. Daily support goes with this kind of mobility + travel support + extra 100 euro support for self-financed students and those with fewer opportunities. [Check the details here](#).
